Street Worker Training



Street Worker Training is a central part of StreetInvest's mission.

Our streetworkers work alongside street children in their own environment - the street. They operate as the significant, safe adult in the life of a street child.

We train our streetworkers to build relationships with and earn the trust of each street child. A streetworker listens but doesn't judge.

In practice the role of a streetworker is varied and can include:

- * Uncovering opportunities and exploring options
- * Recognising & building on street children's strengths
- * Dealing with conflicts
- * Developing networks
- * Acting on their behalf with third parties (family, police, schools etc.)

This year's annual charity week was held in the summer term and sported the theme of fairytales. Charity week comprised of talent shows, plays, food sales, clothes


